

REQUIREMENTS FOR DESIGNATION

All holders of Air Carrier Licence (ACL) issued by GCAA intending to operate sub-regional, regional or international air transport services to another state under the existing Bilateral/Multilateral Air Services Agreements to which Ghana is a signatory, shall be required to apply for Designation.

REQUIREMENTS:

Designation would be granted subject to the applicant fulfilling the following requirements:

- a) must have a valid operating licence (ACL);
- b) have its headquarters, central administration and principal place of business physically located in Ghana;
- c) be duly licensed as defined in Annex 6 of the Chicago Convention, i.e. be a holder of an Air Operators Certificate (AOC) issued by GCAA;

- d) fully own or have a long-term lease exceeding six (6) months on an aircraft and have its technical supervision;
- e) be adequately insured with regard to passengers, cargo, mail, baggage and third parties in an amount at least equal to the provisions of the International Conventions in force, i.e. the Montreal Convention of 1999;
- f) be capable of demonstrating its ability to maintain standards at least equal to those set by ICAO and to respond to any query from any State to which it provides air services;
- e) provide evidence of adequate operational/financial arrangements in respect of the following:
 - Corporate governance and management
 - Office / administrative set up
 - Handling of passengers/cargo
 - Fuel supply
 - Sales agencies at destinations
 - Ticketing
 - Maintenance and safety of operations
 - Capitalisation to meet fixed and operational costs for at least 2 years of operations
